

TECH TIPS

One thing that is really good for detailing black parts, especially under hood, is black appliance epoxy. When cured it has a hard chip-resistant finish. It also comes in white and stainless steel finishes. I found the stainless steel at Lowes.

Keep your *synthetic* detailing and windshield chamois clean, soft and long-lasting. After every use, rinse until clean in fresh water, ring out but leave damp, roll up loosely and put back in its case. Store in a cool area. Note: *natural* chamois should be stored completely dried out.




